Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 18:1-8)



Today's parable presents a widow who stubbornly begs a corrupt judge to grant her justice. Although he cares neither for God nor people, the judge grants the widow's request. Jesus insists that we should pray just as the widow — with persistence. If a corrupt and indifferent judge gives in, how much more will a loving God give to His beloved.

The purpose of persistent prayer is not to change God's mind, but to show that prayer is a commitment rather than a duty. We do have our part to play in prayer.

Saint John Paul II Wednesday October 22, Mass at 12:15 pm

Join us for Mass, and Exposition of the First-Class Relic of the Saint.

Karol Józef Wojtyla, known as John Paul II since his October 1978 election to the papacy, was born in Poland in 1920. ... HE HAS UNDERTAKEN 104 PASTORAL VISITS OUTSIDE ITALY. The attendance of John Paul II for World Youth Day 2002 in Toronto was the third official visit of the Holy Father to Canada. More than 800,000 people crowded Downsview Park for the closing Papal Mass on July 28, 2002. ... John Paul II is patron saint of youth, families, and World Youth Day (*Living with Christ*).

Pope Benedict: Like Sr Faustina, John Paul II in his turn made himself an apostle of Divine Mercy. ... The whole of his mission at the service of the truth about God and man and of peace in the world is summed up in this declaration (...): "APART FROM THE MERCY OF GOD THERE IS NO OTHER SOURCE OF HOPE FOR MANKIND".

St. John Paul II Student Centre

Recognizing the need for and importance of encouraging and supporting the faith of young people, the Diocese of Hamilton and St. Michael Parish founded the St. John Paul II Student Centre in 2015. The Centre is a Catholic home away from home for post-secondary students in Waterloo. It serves the community of Wilfrid Laurier University, the University of Waterloo, and Conestoga College. What is a saint?

ALL CHRISTIANS ARE CALLED TO BE SAINTS. Saints are persons in heaven (officially canonized or not), who lived heroically virtuous lives, offered their life for others, or were martyred for the faith ...

In official Church procedures there are three steps to sainthood: ... *Venerable*, then *Blessed* and then *Saint*. *Venerable* is the title given to a deceased person recognized as having lived a heroically virtuous life. To be recognized as a *Blessed*, one miracle acquired through the candidate's intercession is required in addition to recognition of heroic virtue ... Canonization requires a second miracle after beatification. The pope may waive these requirements. A miracle is not required prior to a martyr's beatification, but one is required before canonization. (*usccb.org*)
