#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 18:1-8)



The parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector is addressed to "those who trust in themselves that they are righteous." The story reveals what kind of prayer penetrates the heart of God.

The man who thinks himself righteous is in fact not, while the one who knows his own faults simply says from the depth of his heart, "Lord, be merciful to me a sinner!" Jesus insists that it is the second one who "goes to his house justified," that is, reconciled, made new. The same could be said of us, if we have the same contrite heart and the need for God's mercy.

Friday, October 28 - Feast of St. Jude and St. Simon. Join us for Mass at 8 am. St. Jude, known as Thaddaeus, was a brother of St. James the Lesser, and a relative of Jesus. He is an author of an epistle (letter) to the Churches of the East, in particular the Jewish converts. St. Jude was the one who asked Jesus at the Last Supper why He would not manifest Himself to the whole world after His resurrection. According to tradition, he was beaten to death with a club. His relics reside at Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome, at Rheims, and at Toulouse, France. Saint Jude Thaddeus is not the same person as Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Our Lord. St. Jude is invoked in desperate situations because his New Testament letter stresses that the faithful should persevere in the environment of harsh, difficult circumstances.

Little is known about **St. Simon the Zealot**. He is thought to have preached in Egypt and then to have joined St. Jude in Persia.

#### We pray the Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. The CWL will lead the Rosary in the parish on **Tuesday's evenings at 6:30** prior to the 7pm Mass. All are welcome to join together in this wonderful prayer.

### What is the Rosary?

The rosary is a combination of vocal and mental prayer, during which we reflect on the important events in the life of Jesus and Mary. Our Catechism calls the Rosary a *meditation* which engages thought, imagination, emotion, and desire (CCC 2708). St. Luis-Marie de Montfort said, "... the more you turn to Mary in your prayers, meditations, actions and sufferings ... the more surely you will discover Jesus."

Pope <u>Saint John Paul II</u> declared the Rosary his favorite prayer, a "prayer for peace and for the family."

Pope Benedict XVI: "without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and His Mother, Mary...this prayer helps to put Christ at the center."

Pope <u>Francis</u>: "a prayer that always accompanies me; it is also the prayer of the ordinary people and the Saints...it is a prayer from my heart."
