Feast of St. John de Brébeuf, St. Isaac Jogues & Companions – Friday, September 26th, Mass 8am

This day honours the eight martyrs of North America, SECONDARY PATRONS OF CANADA – six Jesuit priests and two lay assistants - who died between 1642 and 1649. All came from Europe in response to a call for missionaries to the "new world" ... At Auriesville, NY and at Midland, ON, the shrines erected to the memory of the martyrs attract thousands of pilgrims annually. (Living with Christ)

What is martyrdom?

Catechism: Martyrdom is the supreme witness given to the truth of the faith: it means bearing witness even unto death. The martyr bears witness to Christ who died and rose, to whom he is united by charity. He bears witness to the truth of the faith and of Christian doctrine. He endures death through an act of fortitude. "Let me become the food of the beasts, through whom it will be given me to reach God"- St. Ignatius of Antioch (CCC 2473).

The Canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis took place on September 7th in St. Peter's Basilica. These young men lived remarkable lives close to the Lord. We seek their intercession especially for the young people in our schools, parishes and communities! May their example be an encouragement for us all. (Bishop Crosby, *Heart to Heart*)

Pope Leo:

Pier Giorgio's life is a beacon for lay spirituality. For him, faith was not a private devotion, but it was driven by the power of the Gospel and his membership in ecclesial associations. He was also generously committed to society, contributed to political life and devoted himself ardently to the service of the poor."

Carlo, for his part, encountered Jesus in his family, thanks to his parents, Andrea and Antonia ... and then at school, and above all in the sacraments celebrated

in the parish community. He grew up naturally

integrating prayer, sport, study and charity into his days as a child and young man."
