Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 16:19-31)



The parable of *The Rich Man and Lazarus* highlights the gap between the carousing life of the rich man and the misery of the poor man. It is noteworthy that the rich man does not end up in Hades because of his wealth or immoral conduct but because of his indifference towards Lazarus.

The Lord prompts us to ask, 'Who is Lazarus lying at my door today?' The parable is not meant to give details about the afterlife or scare with images of punishment but to invite us to open our eyes and hearts to those in need around us.

# OUR PARISH FEAST DAY St. Michael the Archangel

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of St. Michael. To mark this occasion, we enjoyed celebrating together at the Parish BBQ. At all Masses we pray a special prayer to St Michael. Prayer cards of St. Michael are available in the narthex. ST. MICHAEL PRAY FOR US!

# Who are the Archangels?

Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are three of the seven archangels who stand before God. **Michael**, ('Who is like the Lord'), considered to be special protector of Israel (Dan 12.1) and of the Church, is known as the 'captain of the heavenly host' (Rev 12.7-9). **Gabriel** ('God is mighty') foretold the coming of the Messiah to the prophet Daniel (Dan 9). Luke records the appearances of this angel to Zachariah and to Mary of Nazareth (Luke 1). **Rafael** ('God heals') identifies himself as one of the angels who bring prayers before God (Tobit 12). He is associated with the healing pool in Jerusalem (John 5). (Living with Christ)
