Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 14. 25-33)



Jesus says, 'whoever comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children ... even life itself, cannot be my disciple." The word *hate* here does not imply hostility; it is an invitation to place Christ in the first place in our life. But for Christ to be the number one in our life does not mean to neglect others. It means the opposite, to love them more deeply and genuinely.
