**UPDATE ON THE BELL TOWER:** BGC Construction and Restoration Ltd. has been contracted to carry out the restoration work on the Bell Tower. All necessary steps will be taken to ensure safety and to protect church property, both inside and out. During the project, some parking restrictions may be necessary due to the presence of construction equipment.

To minimize disruption, daily Masses will be held in the Hall, while funerals will continue to take place in the church. The project is expected to take approximately two months to complete, with a total cost (including diocesan tax) of about \$250,000. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate your understanding. **UPDATE ON BILL C-9:** On March 25th, 2026, Bill C-9, the Combatting Hate Act, passed 3rd reading in the House of Commons and the legislation has now been sent to the Senate for final review and consideration. Numerous aspects of this Bill present serious concerns for faith communities. Canadians of faith are encouraged to engage in the democratic process in an effort to stop Bill C-9 in the Senate. Your prayers and efforts are very much appreciated.

**VOCATIONS APPEAL:** On Good Shepherd Sunday, **April 26,** the Archdiocese is launching a Vocations Appeal; an ongoing initiative to raise awareness and support for the formation of our seminarians. For years we have been praying for vocations. In 2023 we had no seminarians in formation. Today we have six men preparing for the priesthood, and next year we expect to have twelve! Vocations are a gift from God, but the financial cost for supporting them (i.e. room & board, formation, education) is about \$65,000 per seminarian per year. So, the goal for 2026 is \$500,000. Please be generous in your support of vocations.

**LENTEN FOOD DRIVE:** The Lenten Food Drive was a great success! Thanks to your generosity, \$354 in cash was raised, along with 22 boxes of food and hygiene products.
