HIKE FOR LIFE, SATURDAY, APRIL 26: Once again Father Lindsay has agreed to be our designated hiker! Please sponsor Father in raising money for Action Life. On Saturday, April 26, he will be walking 5km in support of this very important pro-life cause. BELL TOWER MAINTENANCE UPDATE: A detailed report on the physical status of the Parish's buildings and exterior areas was prepared by a professional engineering company in 2022. In December 2024, parishioners were advised that the Bell Tower would be the focus of maintenance investments in 2025, as it is suffering water infiltration damage necessitating urgent repairs. The first step is to address the deteriorated environmental state inside the belfry at the top of the tower. Following that, it will be safe to conduct a thorough engineering assessment of the belfry and the rest of the Bell Tower. A detailed review of the physical status of the belfry has been completed by a local firm with specialized experience in this area. A technical team was on site in February and March to set up a containment zone below the belfry to document the state of the inside of the belfry. Safety precautions were followed by establishing a containment zone prior to opening the access port. Once the team completed the preparatory assessment of the interior, the access port was closed, and the contained area was cleaned. The preparation of a report with its findings is underway. The next step was the actual clean-up to render the belfry Tower safe for work assessment and completion. In the next few days, the Finance Council (specifically, the Bell Tower Sub-Committee consisting of Paul Hession, Bev Binette and Brian Gracie) will receive the recommendations arising from this inspection and cleaning. The Sub-Committee will issue updates as the project progresses, including the estimated costs of proposed rehabilitation options of the belfry and the rest of the Bell Tower, Regardless of the selected option, the work will be costly. To this end, special collection envelopes will be available for Parishioners to support this project. Your financial support will be invaluable in the Parish's efforts to bring this project to a successful end.

PRAYING FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR: We have ordered Holy Year prayer cards for parishioners. It is the Pilgrims of Hope prayer composed by Pope Francis for this Jubilee Year. We ask that you have it with you when coming to church so that we can pray it together at the end of Mass in place of the St Michael Prayer. We will begin this once Lent ends (in the Easter season) and continue till the end of the Jubilee Year (January 6, 2026). Once it ends, we will return to praying the St Michael Prayer. CHARITABLE TAX STATUS: During the last Parliament, the Commons Finance Committee received two proposed recommendations, numbered 429 & 430, to Parliament under the Budget Implementation Act, 2023, No. 1. Recommendation 429 suggested that the government should remove the charitable status of organizations that oppose abortion. Recommendation 430 proposed that the definition of "charity" under the Income Tax Act be amended to remove the "advancement of religion" as a recognized charitable purpose. With the dissolution of Parliament for the election, these recommendations have been nullified. A form of them, however, is likely to re-surface in the new Parliament. Catholic organizations are bound to oppose abortion and also to advance religion. Catholics should be wary of attempts to defund the charitable works of the Church. Individuals might consider asking anyone looking for voter support in the present election where the local candidate stands on these recommendations. If the candidate has a website, consider sending an email to your own candidate and asking for the candidate's stance on taxing religious organizations.
