AI-ASSISTED CANVAS PAINTING WORKSHOP "DISCOVERING BEAUTY": A fundraiser for Our Lady of Fatima's Bell Tower! **Sundays, August 23 and 30, 2026, 1:00pm–3:30pm.** Open to everyone—including child/guardian pairs, retirees, and absolute beginners. You won't believe how AI can transform our lives—believe in yourself, because anyone can create a beautiful canvas masterpiece with serious bragging rights! Using the simple Google AI, you will turn a favorite photo or family memory into a custom layout to paint on an 8"x10" canvas. For more details, visit www.fatimaparish.ca. **Cost is \$200.00 and includes both sessions, for 1 or 2 participants working together.** The \$200 registration fee covers the complete two-session program. Because the process is integrated, registration is for the full workshop; we are not offering single session spots. If a participant is under 10 years old, they must be accompanied by a guardian. This ensures the child has the necessary supervision to work with the paints and canvas safely and effectively. Each registration receives one canvas board and one 12-color or 24-color acrylic paint set with brushes. CAMP COUNSELLORS NEEDED FOR CHILAWEE TRAILS CAMP THIS AUGUST: Chilawee Trails Camp is an overnight camp for girls ages 9–14, held annually each August on the shores of Halfway Lake near Barry's Bay, Ontario, in the heart of the Madawaska Valley. Since its founding in 1994, Chilawee Trails has enabled young girls to have fun together enjoying nature, friendship, sports, hiking, dance, drama and crafts in a relaxed atmosphere of cheerful cooperation and to appreciate that having fun is a natural part of a virtuous and faithful life. What began as a small camp of 28 campers has grown into a thriving community serving 56 campers annually, supported by approximately 40 youth leaders and staff. Over the past 30 years, nearly 4,000 young women have participated in Chilawee Trails as campers or leaders, many of whom continue to contribute positively to their schools, parishes, professions, and families. Camp counsellors are still needed for this August. Counselors oversee their cabin and CITs (Counselors-in-Training) are there to support and learn from the counselor. They are always responsible for ensuring the supervision of campers. Assigned support staff members are available to help when needed. The camp directors and camp nurse are also available to aid or advise.

Responsibilities include developing a strong cabin bond with new campers, choosing a cabin name, creating a cheer, and drawing a cabin poster, which facilitates this bonding. Ice breaker and name games are also useful. Counsellors also encourage campers to work together and ensure that no camper feels left out. This helps to foster friendships and to create an atmosphere of cooperation. Staff positions at Chilawee are volunteer and unpaid. We do offer an honorarium to our staff members in thanks for their hard work at the end of the camp period.
