While it is challenging to keep our focus in the midst of many distractions, the gospel calls us to adhere to the words of John the Baptist: prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Our faith community is called to welcome the Messiah who brings about peace and righteousness.

- 2) There should be additional copies of the Advent-Christmas pamphlet available at the entrances of the church. This pamphlet can also be found on our parish website. You can also pick up a copy of "Wonders of His Love: Family Devotions and Activities of Advent" for your perusal. We have a limited quantity of these booklets available on the table near the main Church Entrance.


