LENT BEGINS WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 18: Ash Wednesday comes early this year. We will celebrate Mass with the distribution of ashes at **9:00am, 4:30pm, and 7:00pm**. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Following the 4:30pm Mass, please join us in the hall for our annual Pauper's Supper.

DAYS OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE IN LENT: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. Abstinence from meat is required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal. Abstinence applies to Catholics age 14 and older. Fasting applies to Catholics from age 18 until age 59. Those who are *ill, elderly, pregnant, or otherwise excused* are not obliged to fast or abstain.

CORRECTION: ABSTINENCE ON FRIDAYS DURING LENT: Last week's bulletin stated that all Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat. While this is the Church's general law, in 1984 the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops decreed that Catholics in Canada may instead choose to substitute another penitential practice, such as an act of charity or piety, on Fridays. The choice of this substitute penitential act is left to the individual.

PAUPER'S SUPPER ASH WEDNESDAY: Please join us for our annual Ash Wednesday Pauper's Supper in the parish hall on **February 18th following the 4:30pm Mass**. The Ladies of Fatima serve a simple but hearty meal of homemade soup and rolls to begin the Lenten fasting season. This simple, delicious meal offers a time of reflection and fellowship as we enter one of the holiest times in the church calendar. Good will donations gratefully accepted.

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE: This organization was established by the Canadian Conference of Bishops in 1967 to be the Canadian Catholic church response for international aid and development for countries in the Global South. D&P is also the Canadian "wing" of Caritas International - the largest Catholic humanitarian organization in the world. Each year D&P sponsors the SHARE LENT campaign to raise parish awareness and funds to assist projects in developing countries. This year's theme is **ON TRACK FOR JUSTICE**. Throughout Lent watch for announcements, special prayer intentions and activities to increase our participation in SHARE LENT. Thank you for your interest and support.

SECOND COLLECTION FOR THE BELL TOWER: As you know, our Bell Tower will undergo major repairs this spring. The project is currently in the bidding process. While these repairs are necessary, they are also quite costly. To help finance this important work, we will begin taking a weekly Second Collection near the end of Mass. We sincerely hope this will not affect your regular offertory donations. If each parishioner were able to contribute just a Toonie per week — less than the cost of a cup of coffee — it would make a significant difference. This statement has been approved by 14 Bishops from across Canada, who together form the Permanent Council, CCCB's most authoritative voice between Plenary Assembly meetings.
