FROM THE RCIA CORNER: The time of discernment continues. Our candidates for Full Communion are preparing to make a profession of faith that will underline their faith journey with us. To make that profession authentically they are now prayerfully considering the consequences of this profession, the commitment to live what they proclaim, to be a witness, to embrace the teachings and practices of the Catholic Church. AT the Easter Vigil, as part of the Rite of Reception, they will be asked, "Do you believe and accept all that the Holy Catholic Church believes, teaches and proclaims to be revealed by God?". The are to respond "I do believe and accept..." Please continue to pray for them.

WHAT ARE YOU DOING FOR LENT THIS YEAR? May we suggest Father Josh Johnson's Set Free, a programme of daily reflection on overcoming the Seven Deadly Sins and the corresponding virtues. Father Josh asks "Do you approach the sacrament of Reconciliation, confessing your sins, receiving absolution, only to discover a month later that you are facing the same sins and weaknesses. He posits that, while there may be several reasons for this, it may result from our not being aware of the dominant vices that are below the surface and feed our sins and imperfections. The dominant vices are often termed The Seven Deadly Sins. (Anger, sloth, pride, gluttony, envy, greed, lust) In Set Free Father Josh offers a daily reflection, scripture, prayer, simple fasts and practical suggestions to help us conquer sin and root it out at its source. Full information is available on the free Ascension app. You will need this app to access materials. You may choose to follow the scripture, prayer, fasting and habits with or without the video clips. Whichever approach you choose we would like to invite you to a weekly Zoom gatherings where we will share our experience and support one another on our Lenten journey. These Zoom meetings will be held on **Thursday evenings** from 7-8pm **beginning March 6**.
