MORNING PRAYER DURING LENT: Join us each morning Monday to Saturday, 8:00-9:00am for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, and the Way of the Cross.

THE WAY OF THE CROSS will be prayed after the 5:30 evening Mass throughout Lent. It will be led by the Knights of Columbus on Tuesdays and the Catholic Women's League on Thursdays. All are welcome to join us for these Lenten devotions.

FOOD COLLECTION – There will be a Food Collection at all weekend Masses in Lent. Blue plastic bins will be at the Church entrances, main and St. Joseph.

REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP UPDATE: We now have information regarding our sponsorship family. Mother, father and two children (toddler and preschooler) lived in the same Syrian community all of their lives. They were forced to relocate to Lebanon while Mom was pregnant with their first child. After they settled in Lebanon, they welcomed a second child to their family. They have no family in Canada, and they speak little English. Their extended families live in Syria, Lebanon, Sweden and the USA. Dad hopes to work in car maintenance and Mom hopes to work in hair styling. We are advised that we can expect our family to arrive as early as late February or in March. An apartment has been found for the family close to Our Lady of Fatima School. We are currently contacting our volunteers to seek their assistance to help our family settle in once they have arrived.
