1) Reflection for the First Sunday of Lent: As we enter this joyful season of Lent, we are reminded about our baptismal

- 5) Income tax receipts are available at the exit after Masses, please respect the need for social distancing and be patient!
- 6) I shall facilitate a live-stream Virtual Penitential Service on **Wednesday, March 3 at 10:00am** through YouTube. You can also participate and view the recorded version any time afterwards.
- 7) Lent and Easter liturgical schedules are available online. You can also obtain a printed copy.
- 8) Please be patient and follow all safety protocols and stay heathy!
