LENT: Here are the Church regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Everyone 18 or older, and under 60 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. It is considered fasting if in a day you only have one full meal and two other meals that combined do not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

THINGS TO DO DURING LENT: Some ideas: Reflect on the Sunday Scriptures before Sunday Mass. Give up something you enjoy (desserts, favourite TV program/sport, video games, limit social media time), attend weekday Mass in person, watch Mass daily on TV, attend Eucharistic Adoration (8:00am), attend Way of the Cross on Wednesdays, add extra daily prayer time, fast Monday to Saturday, read the New Testament, save a bit of money each day and give to a Catholic charity, give up smoking or drinking, go to Confession, pray rosary as couple/family, intentional good deed daily for family, friend or neighbour.

PARISH LENTEN MISSION! Scripture scholar and Auxiliary Bishop of Ottawa-Cornwall, Bishop Yvan Mathieu, will lead our Lenten Mission from Sunday, March 26 to Wednesday, March 29 at 7:00pm. A Parish Reconciliation Service will be held during the Tuesday mission. The theme will be "Baptized in God's love... Sent to the world." Mark it on your calendar!

WAY OF THE CROSS: Every Wednesday during Lent, immediately after the morning Mass, our Knights of Columbus and our Catholic Women's League members will follow the Way of the Cross. We ask all parishioners to remain in Church and join us on this journey.

CHRISTIAN MEDITATION PRESENTATION: "Those who want to save their life will lose it; and those who lose their life for my sake will find it." (Matt. 16:25). Father Laurence Freeman tells us we often associate Lent with 'giving something up', but it is also a good time to begin the practice of meditation. Through this discipline we learn to nurture the silence within, come to experience joy and well-being in every area of our lives. You might find that your practice may not end at Easter.
