LENT BEGINS WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 18: Ash Wednesday comes early this year. We will celebrate Mass with the distribution of ashes at **9:00am, 4:30pm, and 7:00pm**. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Following the 4:30pm Mass, please join us in the hall for our annual Pauper's Supper.

DAYS OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE IN LENT: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. Abstinence from meat is required on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. Fasting means one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal. Abstinence applies to Catholics age 14 and older. Fasting applies to Catholics from age 18 until age 59. Those who are *ill, elderly, pregnant, or otherwise excused* are not obliged to fast or abstain.

PAUPER'S SUPPER ASH WEDNESDAY: Please join us for our annual Ash Wednesday Pauper's Supper in the parish hall on **February 18th following the 4:30pm Mass**. The Ladies of Fatima serve a simple but hearty meal of homemade soup and rolls to begin the Lenten fasting season. This simple, delicious meal offers a time of reflection and fellowship as we enter one of the holiest times in the church calendar. Good will donations gratefully accepted.

2026 ENVELOPE BOXES are available in the usher's room. **Please note that if you used an envelope box in 2025, the same number has been given to you for 2026.** All boxes are labelled, so please cross reference your name and address to ensure you pick up the correct box. **These box numbers have been assigned for tax purposes, so it is important that you take the correct box.** Here are a few tips to make sure your contributions are accurately recorded: 1) As of January 1, 2026, please discard any envelopes from previous years. 2) For the first few contributions of the year, please clearly print your name/address on the envelope, as well as the amount of the donation. After that, please print your name and donation amount. **Tax receipts for 2025 will be available by the end of February.** Thank you for your continued support!

DIGNITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY: The weekend of **February 7-8** has been designated Dignity of Human Life Sunday in our Archdiocese. This replaces the Pro-Life Sunday that for many years was held in May. Therefore on **Feb. 7-8** the homily will be oriented toward a pro-life theme. An excerpt from the Archbishop's message notes that in 2026, our focus will be on the sanctity and dignity of human life at the end of life. The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition estimates that over 90,000 Canadians were euthanized between 2016-25. This year, our country will almost certainly break the tragic threshold of 100,000 Canadians whose lives have been snuffed out by MAiD.
