NOTIFICATION CONCERNING FUTURE STAGE 2 LRT: BLASTING. The City of Ottawa and its sub-contractor, DST Consulting Engineers, have notified landowners and residents that blasting will be required as part of Stage 2 LRT. The Parish will be procuring the professional services of an independent engineering firm to document the physical status of the Church and its annexes. This investment will serve the Parish well should any structural damage result from blasting activities. No date has been communicated to the Parish for the commencement of blasting in the Byron Linear Park.
