1) A note of appreciation to all those involved in liturgies during the Advent and Christmas



Season. Special thanks to all those assisting with music & acolyte for the Advent Evening Prayers and all other liturgical ministers at all the Christmas celebrations. You helped greatly to enhance our active participation. We thank also the Worship Space decorators. Thanks also to the Pastoral Care Team who visited the homebound parishioners throughout the year.

- 2) It is not often that Christmas Day coincides with Sunday whenever this happens we shall celebrate the Holy Family on Friday, Dec. 30th, and Epiphany Sunday on January 8th, with the Baptism of the Lord on the following Monday, January 9th. This feast day will conclude the liturgical Season of Christmas.
- 3) Liturgical Focus: **Epiphany of the Lord** Reflection: An epiphany is a manifestation or a showing forth. When the wise men from the East visit Jesus and present their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, Jesus is shown forth as Lord. With this in mind, we may say that every Sunday Eucharist is a new epiphany of the Lord. As a community that shares the wisdom that comes from God, we come together on the Lord's Day and publicly proclaim the lordship of Jesus Christ. Our gift is the gift of our lives for the glory of God.
- 4) Baptism during Mass: Just as anointing of the sick during the Community gathering in worship, the Baptism of infants is more and more frequently being celebrated during Sunday Mass. According to the "Rite of Baptism for Children," #9: "To bring out the paschal character of baptism, it is recommended that the sacrament be celebrated during the Easter Vigil or on Sunday, when the Church commemorates the Lord's resurrection. On Sunday, baptism may be celebrated even during Mass. So that the entire community may be present and the relationship between baptism and Eucharist may be clearly seen." therefore appropriate that the community signs the child after the parents and godparents do so. The community also pledge to support them in their task of bringing the child to the Christian community and pray for the child at the prayer of the faithful. The sacrament is not only for the good of the infant, it is a grace to the whole parish. The child held in the arms of its loving father or mother is an effective sign of who we are before God. "Amen, I say to do, whoever does not accept the Kingdom of God like a child will not enter it" (Luke 18:17). I hope to introduce some infant baptisms during our Sunday Masses, especially for the families who are connected with our parish, so that the community will rejoice together with our parish families with the newly born child.
- 5) In the event that someone inquires why we put the crèche (an important symbol of devotion during the Christmas Season) at the side rather than under the altar, as was the practice here before, I would like to point out that since the Mass is source and summit of Christian life, nothing should distract us from that focus, particularly during the liturgy. (Refer to Guide for Ministers of Liturgical Environment, LTP, 2009).
