I began the process with questions, hopes, and a desire to understand faith more deeply. Over time, I found myself surrounded by people who walked with me and taught me: sponsors who supported me and fellow initiates who shared the same questions and hopes. Gradually, I began to feel something shift, a growing sense of being held up by the prayers and presence of an entire parish. At the Easter Vigil, surrounded by those who had accompanied me, I felt that belonging in a profound way. Baptism was not simply a ritual, but a moment of renewal and commitment, a beginning, not an ending: a commitment to grow, to learn, and to live with intention. AI-ASSISTED CANVAS PAINTING WORKSHOP - "DISCOVERING BEAUTY": A fundraiser for Our Lady of Fatima's Bell Tower! **Sundays, August 23 and 30, 2026, 1:00pm–3:30pm.** Open to everyone—including child/guardian pairs, retirees, and absolute beginners. You won't believe how AI can transform our lives—believe in yourself, because anyone can create a beautiful canvas masterpiece with serious bragging rights! Using the simple Google AI, you will turn a favorite photo or family memory into a custom layout to paint on an 8"x10" canvas. Because the process is integrated, registration is for the full workshop; we are not offering single-session spots. If a participant is under 10 years old, they must be accompanied by a guardian. This ensures the child has the necessary supervision to work with the paints and canvas safely and effectively. Each registration receives one canvas board and one 12-color or 24-color acrylic paint set with brushes. Participants retain ownership of their finished canvas and any remaining painting supplies at the end of the second session. Bring a smartphone and wear an old shirt/apron.
