### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING BYRON CLOSURE

Mark Taylor, Deputy Mayor and Councillor for Bay Ward, accepted our Parish's invitation to participate in a community meeting to discuss the closure of Byron Avenue to motor vehicles from Woodroffe to Lockhart. The meeting took place on Thursday, June 8th with more than 80 parishioners attending. Deputy Mayor Taylor confirmed that the decision, made in late January, is final. Feedback from the meeting and from parishioners who were unable to attend is being reviewed and a joint meeting of the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council was held on June 14th to develop a recommendation of an acceptable option to the Archdiocese and provide a formal response to the City of Ottawa. We need more helpers to enable us to extend communion in both species at all weekend Masses by the First Sunday of Advent. As Many thanks to all those who volunteered to assist as extra-ordinary ministers of communion. We need more helpers to enable us to extend communion in both species at all weekend Masses by the First Sunday of Advent. As I indicated before, communion under both kinds enables the faithful to participate in a "clearer form of the sacramental sign" and heed the words: "Take and eat, take and drink!" Those who attended learnt the importance of properly administering of the precious blood by moving the chalice after carefully wiping the inside and outside rim, the spirituality and theology of communion in both species. According to the general instruction, the faithful are not permitted to dip the host into the previous blood by themselves, not even with the aid of the extra-ordinary ministers!

- 2. For your info: A slight change was made beginning the Canada Day Weekend Masses: The Roman Missal requires that we make the brief announcement after the Prayer after Communion, rather than before, as is our current custom [Prayer after Communion concludes the formal prayer during Mass]. Hopefully, the announcements would be rather brief, and we can remain standing until the final blessings.
- 3. Our parish welcome all who are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian church and seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Please inform me and we shall begin the process without delay! Initiating new Catholic Christians is the responsibility of all the baptized!
- 4. During our parish weekday Mass, our focus is on the Ambo [Real Presence of Christ in the Word of God proclaimed], the Altar [Bread and Wine transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ] and the Presider [who presides over the assembly in the person of Christ]. Additional symbols such as statues do not belong at the sanctuary worship space, as noble as they are! The same applies at the Exposition of the Body of Christ!
