Cost is \$100.00 per person, which includes a charitable tax receipt for \$50.00. Murder mystery dinner includes a three-course roast pork dinner, with a vegetarian option of chickpea korma, and murder mystery and prizes. There will be a cash bar with wine, beer, non-alcoholic beer and soft drinks. **This will be an adults-only event.** Tickets may be purchased using cash, debit, Visa, MC, or cheque through the parish office, either in person or by phone at 613-722-7661. UPDATE ON THE BELL TOWER: BGC Construction and Restoration Ltd. will take **about 11 weeks to complete the work.** All necessary steps will be taken to ensure safety and to protect church property, both inside and out. During the project, some parking restrictions may be necessary due to the presence of construction equipment. To minimize disruption, weekday masses will be held in the Hall, while funerals will continue to take place in the church. Weekend masses will be unaffected. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate your understanding. The project will cost about \$250,000. As this represents a significant expense, we appreciate any additional contribution you are able to make. **You can donate to this campaign - just mark an envelope 'BELL TOWER' and put it in with the regular collection any Sunday.** For those using preauthorized donation methods, you can add special donations for the Bell Tower by calling the office. Donations are also able to be made over the phone by credit card, and we are also able to accept e-transfers. All donations qualify for a tax receipt.
