The pain of this great tragedy has been expressed in the many recent ceremonies, memorials and tributes across Canada. 1) Reflection for the 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time (June 26-27): God brings forth life in the midst of human experience of sin, suffering



and death. The healing and life-giving encounters of the woman who suffered from hemorrhages and the resuscitation of Jairus' daughter show us God's healing power at work in the person of Jesus Christ.

Reflection for the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 3-4): Jesus is the ultimate Prophet who epitomizes his task of being sent by the Father to guide us to live and witness our humanity in relationship to God. He persevered in his mission even though many rejected him because they held the conviction of "familiarity breeds contempt"; nevertheless, those who embrace the truth that he embodies will see the light of life!

- 2) Vaccine update: As the availability of vaccines is constantly changing and increasing thankfully, the number of those who are eligible to receive a second dose of vaccine accelerated. For further details regarding your eligibility for a second dose, please refer to ottawapublichealth.ca.
- 3) As of June 11, the province has allowed 15% attendance in Church. This applies also to weddings. However, funerals are limited to a maximum of 50. The situation improves as a result of increased vaccinations and fewer cases of COVID.
- 4) We are live-streaming Mass every Saturday at 4:30pm. You can participate virtually by going to the parish website and clicking the red button to access the Mass live, or to view the recording afterwards.
- 5) I announced my retirement from active full-time ministry as of the end of July with a farewell message at all Masses the weekend of June 12-13. For safety reasons, no reception will be held. Please check the website under Pastor's message to read my farewell message! I would like to offer my gratitude to all those who offer kind words of appreciation during my stay here at Our Lady of Fatima.
- 6) Fr. Lindsay Harrison, current Pastor of St. John the Apostle Parish, will begin his ministry here as of August 1. He will be assisted by Fr. Dan Van Delst, Chancellor of the Diocese.


