1) Why is the ambo normally reserved for the Word of God? The liturgical instruction states: "The dignity



of the word of God requires the church to have a place that is suitable for proclamation of the word and is a natural focal point for the people during the liturgy of the word...As a rule the lectern or ambo should be stationary, not simply a movable stand...The readings, responsorial psalm and the Easter Proclamation (Exsultet) are proclaimed from the lectern; it may be used also for the homily... It is better for the commentator, cantor, or choir director not to use the lectern." (272). The liturgical guidelines add this: "The dignity of the ambo requires that only a minister of the word should go up to it." (309).

- 2) The Easter Triduum celebration marks the summit of our liturgical calendar. Please mark off your calendar to participate in this three day celebration which starts with the Last Supper on Holy Thursday at 7:30pm, through the Friday Passion at 3:00pm and a special invitation is offered to all parishioners and their friends to participate in the great Easter Vigil, the central and most beautiful liturgical celebration of the year. We gather on Saturday evening at 8:00pm to bless the paschal fire, to dedicate the paschal candle, to listen to the key stories of God's redemptive love. Please mark this on your calendar and plan to attend this great liturgy.
- 3) The Share Lent campaign for Development and Peace fosters peace in a world often torn by strife and violence. On the Fifth Sunday of Lent, our special donation is for the cause of building peace, especially in areas where people suffer displacement and refugees sought safety and security for their families. Also, we have a special donation for the Holy Land on Good Friday, where there is great suffering for the Christians in the area.
- **4)** As we enter into the Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, our Gospel readings deal with the Power of the Suffering and Death of the Savior on the Cross, and our Christian Way of Life comes by way of Dying and Rising. May we draw closer to the Lord during this joyful season of Lent!
- 5) I would like to express my gratitude to parishioners who took part in the Lenten Retreat (mission) last week. I hope this Lenten quiet time encouraged you to foster a deeper relationship with Christ and the Paschal Mystery of his life and ours! I also applaud those who were available for the workshop on Dismissal Catechesis. Your support for the Catechumens and Candidates on the journey to become disciples of Christ is pivotal. The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults states: #4 initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful. By joining the catechumens in reflecting on the value of the paschal mystery and by renewing their own conversion, the faithful provide example to help catechumens obey the Holy Spirit generously. #5 duration of journey varies according to many forms of God's grace, cooperation of the individuals, the action of the Church... #75.1 suitable catechesis is accommodated to the liturgical year and solidly supported by celebrations of the word.


