1) Lenten Reflection: Today’s gospel records the transfiguration of the Lord on the mountain. Peter, John and James were given a glimpse into Jesus’ marvelous life of glory. This life of glory is our destiny as well. In fact, through our celebration of baptism, confirmation and eucharist, we have already begun to share in this remarkable gift, and the annual festival that lies ahead of us draws us ever more deeply into that mystery. Should we not, then, look forward to the feast with great expectation and joy? And should we not prepare ourselves to celebrate the feast with open hearts, so that the Lord may work his transforming power in our lives? This week is a good time for us to reflect on the wonderful things that God does in our lives. This kind of reflection will help us all to set aside whatever stands in the way of our transfiguration in Christ. (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165).

2) Please pick up a copy of the liturgical schedules for Lent-Easter Season. Please note that our Lenten Reconciliation Service with individual absolution will be celebrated on Tuesday, April 4th at 7:00pm. Also, individual confession is available through the Lenten Period at 4:00pm every Saturday evening, and as well before every weekday Mass.

3) The collection is a liturgical act. It is taken up with the gifts. It is important that the significance of the collection as a sign of our self-offering be maintained. Therefore, people who have arranged to give their regular offerings through the pre-authorized debit plan are asked to still use envelopes. Simply mark “PAD” on the envelope and deposit it in the collection basket. There is no need to put any amount, since that record is kept by the pre-authorized debit plan. Alternatively you may drop a pink visitor envelope in the basket – there is no need to mark anything on the envelope. This gesture will maintain the symbolic meaning of the offering.

4) As we embark upon the Season of Lent, it is good to reflect upon the Role of the Assembly: As a member of the gathered assembly each of us has a role to play. We are called to take part with our whole mind, body and soul. We are called to full, conscious, and active participation. We arrive on time, prepared to praise and honour and give thanks to God. Aware that we are part of the body of Christ and not isolated individuals, we show hospitality to one another and are present to each other throughout the liturgy. We sing the songs with vigour, we listen attentively to the proclamation of the Word and the priest’s homily, we observe the moments of prayerful silence, and we pray the prayers and responses of the liturgy with conviction. We perform the ritual gestures like the sign of the cross and the sign of peace with care. During the Eucharistic prayer we unite ourselves to the words and actions of the priest. We join in the communion procession and sing and receive communion reverently. We do not leave until we are dismissed and our recessional song is completed. Then we remain if possible to visit with other members of the community. We go forth, spiritually recharged to live our lives as followers of Christ. (Celebrate, v.44#2 (2005), p. 26-27).
