ASH WEDNESDAY IS MARCH 5TH: We will be having masses with distribution of ashes at 9:00am, 4:30pm and 7:00pm. There will be our Pauper Supper of homemade soups in the Hall beginning at 5:00pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. See the canonical requirements for fasting and abstinence in this bulletin.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE DURING LENT: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting *and* abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday. Everyone 18 or older, and under 60 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. It is considered fasting if in a day you only have one full meal and two other meals that combined do not equal a full meal. Eating between meals on fast days is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the regulations do not apply.

SUGGESTIONS FOR LENT: Lent is a sacred penitential season with the intention of drawing closer to God. It begins Ash Wednesday. This year consider doing something special to make it more meaningful. Here are some suggestions from which to choose. Some you may already be doing. If so then consider adding another practice just for Lent!

- Pray the Rosary daily. Individually or as a couple/family.
- Go to daily Mass. We have Mass at 9:00am Monday to Saturday.
- Do a daily Holy Hour. We have one from 8:00am till Mass, Mon.-Sat.
- Participate in the Stations of the Cross. Here every Friday during Lent at 9:30am.
- Attend our Lenten Mission. With Fr. Allen MacDonald, CC, March 24-26 at 7:00pm.
- Read the Bible daily for 15 minutes. Begin with the Gospels.
- Abstain from meat on Fridays. And maybe add Wednesdays too!
- Choose small sacrifices at meals, such as drinking water instead of juice, coffee or tea, skipping dessert, or abstaining from snacks between meals.
- Restrict your time on social media. Cut it by at least half if not more.

- Dedicate time to silence by turning off music, podcasts, television and using that time for reflection or prayer. We have a Meditation group every Saturday at 9:45am in the lower room.
- Spend time helping others through charitable acts or community service. Volunteer at our Coffee Sunday.
- Put aside some money each day to donate to a charity.
 These practices can help deepen your faith and prepare you spiritually for Easter.



PAUPER'S SUPPER ASH WEDNESDAY: Please join us for our annual Ash Wednesday Pauper's Supper in the Parish Hall on **March 5th** following the 4:30pm Mass. The Ladies of Fatima serve a simple but hearty meal of

homemade soup and rolls to begin the Lenten

fasting season. This simple, delicious meal offers a time of reflection and fellowship as we enter one of the holiest times in the church calendar. Please join us after the 4:30pm Mass to 7:00pm. Good will donations are gratefully accepted.

THE WAY OF THE CROSS: Members of our Knights of Columbus and Catholic Women's League will lead The Way of the Cross every Friday morning right after the 9:00am Mass during the Lenten season. We ask you to please join us as part of your Lenten activity.

PARISH RECONCILIATION SERVICE IN LENT: Our parish Reconciliation Service in Lent will be held on Wednesday, April 2nd beginning at 7:00pm. There will be a number of priests available for individual confession. It is greatly encouraged to go to Confession during Lent, especially if it has been quite some time since your last Sacramental Confession.

FROM THE RCIA CORNER: On the first Sunday in Lent the Church across the world gathers to celebrate the readiness of catechumens and candidates to take the next step on the road to Easter sacraments. It is a special and powerful liminal moment. In our archdiocese the archbishop will gather all seekers on Sunday afternoon March 9th at 2:30pm at the cathedral. He will recognize our three candidates for Full Communion with the Catholic Church, Anjola, Careen and Majella for the Rite of Reception at the Easter Vigil. They receive a special blessing as they prepare their hearts to make a profession of faith, just before being confirmed and begin to share in the Eucharist with us. Please continue to pray for them and, if possible, plan to attend.
