The theme is "Hope is Not a Plan." There will be a Mass each evening. Father Allan will make himself available for Confessions before (6:00pm) and after (till 9:00pm) each weekday Mission. DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE: Peru is facing a debt crisis, even as extractive industries, some Canadian owned, plunder its natural resources, harming environmental and human rights. These industries contribute to the unjust enrichment of the Global North at the expense of the Global South. As countries in the Global South incur financial debts that impoverish them, they are OWED a mounting ecological debt by the Global North that is never settled. D&P's partners, the Episcopal Commission for Social Action and the Institute Bartolome de La Casas, work closely with affected communities advocating for justice and sustainable alternatives.
