FASTING & ABSTINENCE DURING LENT: Correction: In the announcement on Fasting and Abstinence during Lent I mentioned that everyone 14 years and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In Canada it is not mandatory to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent, just Good Friday. While Fridays throughout the year are still considered days of abstinence, the CCCB allows the substitution of other penitential practices, acts of charity or piety instead. Sorry for the confusion. SUGGESTIONS FOR LENT: Lent is a sacred penitential season with the intention of drawing closer to God. It begins Ash Wednesday. This year consider doing something special to make it more meaningful. Here are some suggestions from which to choose. Some you may already be doing. If so then consider adding another practice just for Lent!

- Pray the Rosary daily. Individually or as a couple/family.
- Go to daily Mass. We have Mass at 9:00am Monday to Saturday.
- Do a daily Holy Hour. We have one from 8:00am till Mass, Mon.-Sat.
- Participate in the Stations of the Cross. Here every Friday during Lent at 9:30am.
- Attend our Lenten Mission. With Fr. Allen MacDonald, CC, March 24-26 at 7:00pm.
- Read the Bible daily for 15 minutes. Begin with the Gospels.
- Abstain from meat on Fridays. And maybe add Wednesdays too!
- Choose small sacrifices at meals, such as drinking water instead of juice, coffee or tea, skipping dessert, or abstaining from snacks between meals.
- Restrict your time on social media. Cut it by at least half if not more.

- Dedicate time to silence by turning off music, podcasts, television and using that time for reflection or prayer. We have a Meditation group every Saturday at 9:45am in the lower room.
- Spend time helping others through charitable acts or community service. Volunteer at our Coffee Sunday.
- Put aside some money each day to donate to a charity.

These practices can help deepen your faith and prepare you spiritually for Easter.



PARISH LENTEN MISSION: Our Lenten Mission, with Father Allan MacDonald of the Companions of the Cross, will begin at the weekend masses, **March 22-23, then continue Monday to Wednesday, March 24-26, at 7:00pm.** The theme is "Hope is Not a Plan." There will be a Mass each evening. Father Allan will make himself available for Confessions before (6:00pm) and after (till 9:00pm) each weekday Mission. Mark it on your calendar!

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE was established in 1967 by the Conference of Canadian Bishops as the official international humanitarian aid organization for Catholics in Canada. The theme for this year's Share Lent campaign is "Pilgrims of Hope" where Pope Francis, in the spirit of this Jubilee year, invites Catholics to renew their hope and vision to "restore access to the fruits of the earth for everyone." One practical way to do this is "to forgive the debts of countries that will never be able to pay them and turn DEBT INTO HOPE." (message of World Day of Peace, January 1, 2025). At Our Lady of Fatima, we encourage your participation on two weekends in Lent: On **March 15/16**, we will ask for your signatures on a global petition to forgive the debt for impoverished countries of the Global South. In Canada, we are hoping to get 100,000 signatures to feed into a global goal of 10 million. The petition will be available to sign at both church entrances at all weekend masses. On **April 5/6, SOLIDARITY SUNDAY**, we will ask parishioners to give generously to the work of D&P – Caritas Canada to support over 79 projects in 34 countries around the world. As in past years, "coin jars" will be available throughout Lent for you to take home, fill-up and return on Solidarity Sunday – a wonderful family activity! Thank you in advance for participating in both events.
