ROAD CLOSURE OF WOODROFFE AVE. BETWEEN RICHMOND AND KNIGHTSBRIDGE ROAD will occur as soon as Friday, May 26 and for approximately three weeks. This is in order to remove the temporary bridge currently supporting the roadway between Byron Avenue and Richmond Road. Work will

be occurring day and night, on weekdays and weekends. Pedestrian connectivity will be maintained throughout the closure. Within the closure area, access to parking at Hulse, Playfair and McGarry Funeral Chapel will be maintained on Woodroffe Avenue, just past the closure signage. All access to Our Lady of Fatima Church will be via the Knightsbridge entrance only as the Byron Avenue access will be closed and barreled off.

ROAD DETOUR – EASTBOUND RICHMOND BETWEEN NEW ORCHARD AVENUE AND MCEWEN AVENUE: As part of the Stage 2 O-Train Light Rail Transit (LRT) project, Richmond Road will now be closed to eastbound vehicles, along with the existing westbound Richmond Road closure, travelling between New Orchard Avenue to McEwen Avenue. Vehicles will be detoured along Ambleside Drive. Begins as early as Tuesday, May 23 until Sunday, October 1, 2023.
