ADVENT FOOD & TOILETRY DRIVE: Thank you for your contributions during the year for the Britannia Food Pantry. We have collected 65 boxes of goods since introducing the boxes at the Church entrances earlier this year! For the increased needs at Christmas, a special Advent Food & Toiletry Drive will be held on the first two weekends of Advent — Nov. 29/30<sup>th</sup> and Dec. 6/7<sup>th</sup>. Most needed food items include rice, flour, instant & ground coffee (large sizes of these are welcome as they can be divided into smaller portions), oil (regular sized bottles) and baby formula (powder/liquid); most needed hygiene items include toothpaste & toothbrushes (incl. children's sizes), shampoo, body wash/soap bars and feminine pads. ST. VINCENT DE PAUL "Bundle Sunday" weekend is Jan. 9-11. Is the arrival of snow this past week FINALLY nudging you to put away your lighter clothing and sort out your winter items for those still useful to you? We can help!! The St. Vincent de Paul store TRUCK will be in our east parking lot the week-end of Jan. 9-11 to receive any donations you wish to contribute, along with light household goods you no longer need. More notice of this event will follow in December but, for those making a clothing switch now, we suggest you put items aside at home in a large black plastic bag, and bring them to the truck Jan. 9-11. \*It is important to know that our OLOF conference has served several recently arrived immigrants from Africa this past month who have come, of course, with NO winter clothing for themselves and their children. Thanks to your financial generosity we have been able to give them vouchers to choose their own at the SVP store. Thank you!

**DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE:** Last spring, following Pope Francis's Jubilee Year initiative to TURN DEBT INTO HOPE for 30 countries where debt payment exceeds investment in health and education, you were invited to sign a petition asking for debt forgiveness, and 640,000 individuals around the world did! A large number of those signatures (maybe yours!) were presented at a meeting of officials from the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank at their meetings in Washington this fall. Time will tell the effect your action has had, but a similar initiative in 2000 "erased" over \$100 billion of debt for over 36 countries. A big hurdle now, different from 2000, is that more monies are loaned by private creditors (rather than by the governments of the lenders), who might be harder to persuade. Please keep this project in your prayers, that hearts are opened, and we will keep you updated as to its outcome. Thanks for your support of D&P.

URGENT BILL C-218 AWARENESS: In June 2025, the member of parliament (MP) for Cloverdale-Langley City introduced private member's Bill C-218: An Act to amend the Criminal Code (medical assistance in dying) to add the following exclusion: (2.1) For the purposes of subsection (2), a mental disorder is not a grievous and irremediable medical condition. Bill C-218 is an important bill in ongoing efforts to protect vulnerable populations from choosing to die because Canada does not have adequate resources to treat mental illness. It is scheduled for second reading in the House of Commons on Dec. 5th. In the 2nd reading, the MP who put forward the bill outlines the principles of the bill, followed by a debate and a vote. If the vote passes, the bill is referred to a committee that studies it and may hear witnesses and make amendments before referring it back to the House for a third and final reading. Second reading is a crucial step in the process, as if the vote is unsuccessful, it dies there. Please inform others and request that they urgently contact their MPs to ask them to support Bill C-218. Letters, emails and telephone calls are important.
