1) I have put a copy of the Ottawa Sun article written by our Archbishop entitled "Pornography" on the bulletin board at the Main

Entrance of the Church for your information.

- 2) Parishioners are always encouraged to be involved in ministries and services in the life of the parish community. This is an exercise in discipleship, to serve the needs of our faith community. For example, we shall be extending Holy Communion in both species at all weekend Masses, and we will need more extra-ordinary ministers to make this happen. We also need more hospitality ministers and lectors, so please do not hesitate to connect with the co-ordinators of these ministries.
- 3) As the only priest serving the parish, I have had to make some changes in weekday Masses and the Masses at nursing homes. We shall keep the regular weekday morning Masses from Monday to Saturday, but eliminate the Tuesday and Thursday evening 5:30pm Masses, while keeping the 4:30pm Wednesday evening Mass. New Orchard Lodge will have Mass on Frist Fridays and Carlingview Retirement Home on the last Tuesday of the month. This revised schedule will begin as of October 1st.
- 4) During the course of the year there are several morning Masses when we welcome the children of Our Lady of Fatima and Dr. F. J. McDonald Schools. The first one will be Thanksgiving Mass on Thurs. Oct. 5. Since the schools can only arrive at 9:30am and I am the only priest available, I shall have to move the Mass on these days ahead a half-hour to 9:30am instead of 9:00am. Adoration and Benediction will be cancelled on these days. I shall give you advance notice. It is good for the Masses to be intergenerational, and I urge you to welcome the children to celebrate with us. Children and teachers will have designated seats, please accommodate.
- **5)** Do you know someone who has expressed an interest in becoming Catholic, has a child over the age of seven who has not been baptized, or was baptized Catholic as a child but has not celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist? We offer an opportunity to participate in the process with your questions, your insights and your faith story. For information, please contact me.
