BELL TOWER MAINTENANCE UPDATE: Thank you to parishioners who attended the meeting on September 11th. Andrew Van Bakel attended on behalf of Keller Engineering. A visual presentation was followed by a lively question and answer period. Most questions related to future maintenance requirements of the two options identified by Keller Engineering and the related costs. The proposed ventilation system and the timing of the work rounded out the discussion. The Sub-committee has met to discuss the issues raised during the meeting. Keller Engineering will be asked to provide more detailed estimates for both options. The information will help the Sub-committee in its decision-making. While Keller Engineering prepares the requested estimates, the Sub-committee will be discussing funding while situating the Bell Tower expenditure within the list of other repairs identified by Keller Engineering in April, 2022. Progress on these fronts will be shared with you in the coming weeks and months.
