Easter People



As Christians we are called Easter People. Have you ever thought about our fascination and exceptional focus

on the Easter experience? Why aren't we Christmas people? The focus on Easter is an important one, because it celebrates the manifestation of Jesus as God. Jesus reveals Himself to us slowly through his incarnation at Christmas, his teachings and miracles during his life. Jesus even reveals his profound love for us through his passion and death.
