

From the Pastor's Desk:

I often like to wonder about my relationship with the Lord. I like to think that my devotion to Him, my love for Him, that my relationship with Him is growing. But there are moments when I simply realize that I continue to struggle with the same sins; that my conversion process does not seem to be going anywhere.

Throughout my journeying with Christ I have often relied on the example of others, for it is their love for

Christ made manifest through their works that has so often given me the strength to remain faithful. By looking to my brothers and sisters in Christ who, despite many difficulties, have remained close to the Lord I am energized, enriched and filled with a renewed strength to keep journeying with Jesus.

Have you ever had the experience of meeting someone that you admired for a long time? It can be a musician, or a great writer, or maybe even a spiritual leader. Well, I had that experience during World Youth days here in Toronto. John Paul II has been a person that I greatly admired even before I began studying his philosophy. My admiration for him grew as I was trying to follow the development of his thought through his writings. I have seen movies about him and read his biography. You might say that I knew John Paul II long before I met him, but I do not think I did. I think that I knew much about John Paul, but I only began knowing him personally when I was invited to speak with him. Being able to meet him was one of the most grace-filled moments in my life, because it comprised of a personal encounter.

There is a great difference between knowing facts about someone, and knowing someone personally. There is a great difference between knowing about Jesus, and knowing Jesus. To know Christ implies a personal encounter with Him. Paul understood this very well, for it is because of his personal encounter with Christ that Paul's life was changed. Through his personal encounter with Christ Paul began a new life of spiritual growth. Nothing else mattered anymore, because he met Christ. No material good was important anymore because he knew Christ. No amount of law based action would replace his relationship with Christ. We too must ask ourselves a very important question: Do I know Christ? We might have spent an X number of years in the seminary, in the Church, praying fervently every morning and every evening, but can we honestly say that we KNOW CHRIST? He is real, he is alive, he wants to be known by us. This is why He came! This is why He died! This is why He Rose from the Dead! He is in love with us, and he invites us to FALL IN LOVE WITH HIM!




