

From the Pastor's Desk:

 Three Lessons from Mary and Joseph - Mary and Joseph are at the centre of the Christmas story. Both are surprised by the events which God makes present in their lives, and yet both accept the will of God with great joy and faithfulness. They teach us three basic attitudes that will help us to prepare for our personal encounter with God.

- <u>Do God's will.</u> The first lesson is the most important one. If we want to be truly happy and fulfilled in life we should simply DO GOD'S WILL. Only the creator knows what is best for the creature. God created us for a specific purpose, and that is to know, love, and serve God. The more we follow God's instructions the more fulfilled we will be. Notice the answer that Mary gives to the angel "Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it done unto me according to your word". Joseph must have been a man of few words, for no words of his are recorded in Sacred Scripture, only his actions: "When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him".
- 2. Know God's will. But in order for us to do God's will, we must know what it is. This is where our knowledge of the faith becomes very important. This is why every Sunday we are nourished by the Word of God, listening to Scripture readings and trying to understand what they mean for us. Mary and Joseph knew their faith very well, they knew that God promised to send a Messiah, born of a virgin, who would save their people. We too must know our faith in order for us to know what God is asking of us. The knowledge of our faith will help us to love God, and to speak to Him and to listen to Him through our prayer life. God also wants to speak to us individually through prayer, to help us in our individual vocations in life. We cannot do what God asks, unless we know what He asks.
- 3. <u>Trust God.</u> Mary and Joseph surely did not understand how their lives are going to play out. They were not given a detailed instruction about what to do for the rest of their lives. God asked them to do something that seemed impossible. But they said yes because they trusted God. In order for us to do God's will, we must trust our God unconditionally. It is not enough to believe in God, we must also trust Him. Only then will we be able to submit our wills to His.

Our journey of faith continues, and we don't know where it will take us. As long as we are on the journey it's important that we stay close to the Lord. We do this by remaining in the state of grace. The sure way of remaining close to God is by making frequent use of the sacrament of confession. It will take away any impediment that we may have on our way to God, and will help us to always respond to God's will in our lives with the attitude of Joseph and the words of Mary: "Let it be done to me, according to your Word".
