First Communion Registration – We are now taking registrations for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion. How do I donate if I don't carry cash - Many people no longer carry cash, and cheques are becoming less widely used. So how does someone with a pocket full of cards make a donation at church? CanadaHelps might be the tool you are looking for. CanadaHelps was founded in 2000 by a group of university students who were specifically looking for an easy way to make electronic donations at church. As a charity itself, their goal is to help all Canadian charities to securely collect online donations. Simply search St Mary's Parish & Missions at canadahelps.org and you can quickly and easily make a one-time donation, or set up a monthly reoccurring donation on a schedule that suits you. Payment options are credit card, PayPal, or Google Pay. Online donations are forwarded to the parish on a weekly basis. Please note that CanadaHelps will send you a donation tax receipt directly; donations will not be receipted through the parish.

Also, please note that CanadaHelps is to only be used for donations. Payments for items that cannot receive charitable tax receipts, (i.e.: gift shop and missal purchases, Mass intentions, funeral expenses), are not to be made through CanadaHelps.
