



### From the Pastors Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

Continuing our discussion of Adoration, today I'd like to talk about what it means that Jesus is present in the Eucharistic Host.

The catechism says, "The mode of Christ's presence under the Eucharistic species is unique. In the most blessed

sacrament of the Eucharist "the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained." "This presence is called 'real' - by which is not intended to exclude the other types of presence as if they could not be 'real' too, but because it is presence in the fullest sense: that is to say, it is a substantial presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present" (CCC 1374).

The church recognizes that Christ can be present in many ways. Christ is present in his creation. He is present in the hearts of the baptized faithful. He is present when two or three are gathered in his name. But only in the Eucharist is Christ substantially present. To be substantially present means you can point to it and say, "that is Jesus". While the Christ is present in the soul of a baptized person, we cannot point to it and say that is Jesus. In our souls, Jesus is present spiritually. In the Eucharist he is present substantially.

With this gift of the Eucharist, Christ invites us to come and spend time in his real presence. Just as a couple, when separated, long to be in each other's presence, so our hearts long to be in the presence of Our Lord. No words need to be spoken; we just want to be with him.

That is what we do in adoration.

Ash Wednesday Masses will be at 9 am, 12 noon, and 7 pm in Owen Sound.

Ash Wednesday falls on February 14th this year and



is a day of fasting and abstinence. Fasting means that we take only one full meal throughout day and abstinence means that we do not eat any meat. We can still eat small portions at two other times of the day, as well

as liquids. In short, we try not to eat as much as we would in a normal day. The concept of fasting and abstinence is found in the Bible in both the Old and New Testaments. When fasting in conjunction with prayer it is believed that our prayers become more effective. Fasting applies to those above the age of 14 and below the age of 69, and abstinence applies to all.

Stations of the Cross - The Stations of the Cross is a devotion, especially during Lent, that prayerfully follows



Jesus' path to the Cross. Every Church contains the 14 stations, and it can be prayed at any time. In Owen Sound this devotion is celebrated every Friday of Lent at 7 pm, beginning this Friday, February 16th. Please come and join us.

Parish Lenten Retreat - Fr. David will be holding a parish Lenten Retreat on Saturday, March 2 starting at 10:30 am at St. Mary's Church in Owen Sound. This is the first retreat for St Mary's and the Missions in a long time, so please mark your calendars and plan to attend. Invite family and friends. Lunch will be provided by St. Mary's and St. Thomas Aquinas CWL members.
