From the Pastor's Desk:



Being with Christ - Jesus chooses to use Peter's boat to speak to the crowds. Peter puts out with Jesus on the boat a little ways from the shore so that the crowds would not crush Jesus, and so that the water could amplify the voice of Jesus and everyone would hear. Now imagine this, Peter is sitting in this boat, listening to the message of Jesus, having the best seat in the house. And he just listens, soaks it all in, perhaps for the first time in his life. Before anything can happen in our lives, we must allow Christ's teaching to reach us. We must allow Him to come into our own boats, our own lives. We

must become fascinated with Him and just let Him talk. Reading Sacred Scripture, listening to the teachings of Jesus and His Church, learning our faith. This can only happen within our own prayer life. If we do not pray, we will not hear!

Trusting Christ - After Jesus is finished speaking He asked Peter to "put into the deep and let down his nets for a catch". Jesus was not a fisherman, Peter was. Peter knew that this was not a good time to go fishing. Peter looked with the eyes of reason and saw this as a bad choice. Jesus asks Him to look with the eyes of faith and Peter chose to listen. What follows is a miracle, a great catch in the middle of the day. Whenever we are trying to discover what vocation God is calling us to, we must always look with the eyes of faith. God has a tendency to surprise us when it comes to vocation stories. Human wisdom might tell us that the decision we are making is the worst decision in our lives, leaving everything behind, all the good things that life has to offer. Only by trusting Christ completely will we be able to say no to the world and follow His call.

Seeing clearly in Christ - When we spend enough time with Christ and see the miracles that He performs in our lives, we begin to see ourselves in a clear light. Peter was not trying to be shy when he said: "Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man", he was being honest. He was sinful, and not fit to be in the presence of God. I can imagine Jesus looking back at Peter and saying: "I know exactly who you are, I created you, I know that you are a sinner. But I am calling YOU". We will never make sense of the choices that God makes. The key to being a follower of Christ is not being extremely gifted, the key lies in being OPEN to follow Him with no questions asked.

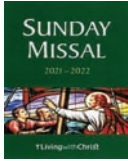
