

From the Pastor's Desk:

Jesus Become One of Us. Even though John is reluctant to baptise Jesus, the Lord persuades him to do so. This is not because Jesus had sins that needed to be washed away. We know that Jesus was without sin, He was perfect, He was God. And John knew this very well, hence his reluctance. But Jesus chooses to be baptised, for the same reason that He chooses to be born in Bethlehem, for the same reason that He chooses to experience pain and suffering. Jesus chooses purposely to put himself on the side of sinners. He chooses solidarity with humans, in all

their frailty. This is so that He can never be accused of not understanding; not knowing what it is like for us to have to suffer. He takes on our sins, our sufferings, in order to save us from them. He became one of us, so that we may become holy like Him. This is why we can never accuse God of not understanding our suffering, or not knowing that it is difficult to be a follower of Jesus. He knows, He did it, and suffered more than any human being. And He did it for us. God cares about us, and understands our struggles There are many questions that we still do not have answers to. We do not know why certain evils happen, and why certain blessings do not. But we know that this is never because God doesn't care, because He doesn't understand.

We have received that gift of everlasting life from God who became one of us in order to save us. May we never squander that gift by lives of selfishness and self-justification. If we recognize the need for Christ in the midst of our weaknesses, we can be sure that Christ will come and help us. If we want Christ in our lives, we must prepare our hearts.

Some people say that they do not feel close to God, that they get nothing out of Mass, that they don't see any effects of being a Catholic. The question that we must ask is: "Have we made the necessary preparations for the coming of Christ? Are we humble people, aware of our sinfulness and of our need for Christ's help? The proud, self-sufficient people will not enter the Kingdom of God, but the humble will dwell in the house of the Lord forever and ever.


