In the Parish

Scent Free Facilities – Just a friendly reminder that all our parish churches are **scent free**. Due to allergies and other health concerns of our parishioners, we ask that you refrain from using perfumes and other strong scents while attending Mass or other church functions. We appreciate your cooperation.

Sacrament of the Sick - Please contact the parish office if someone needs the Sacrament of the Sick. This sacrament should be requested when the individual begins to be in danger of death due to sickness or old age. Unless there is an unforeseen emergency, it is not proper to delay this sacrament until the final days or moments of a person's life. Ideally, the person should be conscious and able to participate in the rite and experience the peace and healing that this sacrament confers.

Collective Mass Intentions - Beginning in January


2026, there will be a change in the scheduling of Mass intentions. Our Diocese allows us to offer Masses for multiple intentions. We will begin this in the New Year on **Saturdays at 5:00 pm**

Mass in Owen Sound. The Mass can be offered for multiple intentions because each Mass is infinite value and the grace is not "divided" between the intentions, but each intention receives the full benefit of the Mass. When there are multiple intentions, they will all be read aloud at the Mass.

Have you considered PAR? – PAR (Pre-Authorized Remittance) is an easy and convenient way to regularly donate to the parish directly from your bank account monthly. Started in 1976, PAR is administered by the United Church in Canada. It supports thousands of churches across Canada of all denominations. Locally, our parish joined the PAR program in 2005, making it simple for our own parishioners to support our parish without the weekly hassle of digging for cash to put into an envelope. We currently have 155 parishioners making use of the program. These monthly donations are an integral piece of our operating budget. Through PAR, we receive \$15,500 in operating funds, and \$1,700 in building funds, each and every month. If this is a program you would like to join, forms are available at the back of the church, at the parish office, and on our website.
