From the Pastor's Desk:



During one of his school visits a priest asked grade 2 student a question: "Why did God create us?" There were many wonderful answers, some quite good, others just humorous. One answer caught the priest's attention, and it was this:

"God created us so that He would not have to be alone". This answer was far from truth, after all God is never alone, but was, is and always will be in communion with others. God did not create us out of a need; God created us out of love. Even though this answer was wrong, it revealed a certain truth about us and the need of a human heart, the need not to be

alone. God created us for community, to belong, to share, to love. As we look at the gift of creation we begin to see God sharing His life of community with us. When Adam is created he is in need of someone. God creates Eve and enters into communion with them. They are not alone, they have each other and they have God's friendship. This is the picture of paradise. It all falls apart when Adam and Eve begin to destroy their communion: first, with God by falling into sin; and then with each other by blaming one another for the sin. The temptation is always there for people to leave their relationship with God, with the Church, with their Christian family in search of freedom, self-sufficiency, and independence. They proclaim to the world that they have reached reasonable freedom by becoming atheists or agnostics. They no longer have to listen to anvone. follow anyone's rules. They are free. But what are they free from? Community of love with God and others. We are made for communion, and without it we experience spiritual death. During these times of isolation due to the health conditions and the weather restrictions, we may begin to feel the effects of isolation, of this lack of communion. When we do, it is time to lean in and find new ways to enter into communion with God and with one another. February is a short month, we can do it.


