

The Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate, a Ukrainian Catholic Congregation, purchased the former Wynnstay Estate in 1946 and named it Mount Mary Immaculate. From the start, Mount Mary has served as a school of religious formation, an orphanage/children's home, and a private residential and day high school for girls. In 1976 Mount Mary began hosting retreats and continues to do so. **July 22<sup>nd</sup> – St. Mary Magdalene:** Mary Magdalene was a faithful follower of the Lord. With the other women, she stood near the cross, brought spices to anoint the body and alone, weeping with grief, was the first witness to the resurrection of Christ.

**July 26<sup>th</sup> – Saints Anne & Joachim**: the gospels give us few details regarding Mary's parents. Devotion to Anne was popular in the 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> centuries – depicted in the number of churches bearing her name. Joachim was honoured in the East from the earliest days, though not until 1584 were they both entered into the Roman calendar.


