From the Pastor's Desk:

Building Project Update – The work on the Phase 1 of our building project has begun. Allen Hastings Ltd. started the work, as they promised, on July 15th. They have already taken the brick off the parish hall west wall, moved the statue of the holy family, dug a hall to expose and move the service lines, and prepared for the foundation of the new parish offices. They are moving quickly and after one week of work they are already one day ahead of schedule.

The preparatory work on Phase 2 of the project continues with our Building Committee. We have now prepared the necessary documentation for a Building Demolition Permit for the Rectory and submitted it to the City. We hope to have a meeting with the representatives of the City Hall to explain our reasons for wanting to proceed with the demolition of our rectory building.

Capital Campaign comes to an end for our parish. We will have one more opportunity for people to make a commitment over the next 2 weekends. Special forms will be available at the back of all our churches for those who would like to make a pledge. The forms can be placed in the collection baskets during Mass. Thank you to everyone who has supported this Diocesan initiative. For those who would like to make a gift towards our Building Project in the future, a donation directly to the parish under the heading "Building Project" will be greatly appreciated.

Open House at the Priests House – during the month of August priests are inviting parishioners to come to the rectory for conversations with priests.
