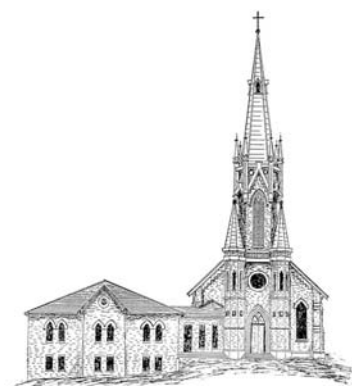

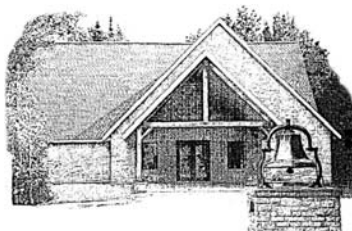

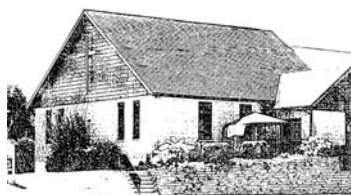

Show Love *a woman's perspective*
Every month for the last year, on the second Tuesday, I have joined a group of women (my high school graduating class) for a zoom. It's been fascinating learning about their lives; what they have done; where they have gone; who they have become. They always have questions for me about Canada – they are often clueless as to what goes on here, and I love telling them about this amazing country I now call home.

This past Tuesday I could not participate in the zoom; this past Tuesday I was overcome with a deep sorrow for this country, and I knew I would not be able to articulate it to these women – this country I am so very proud to live in and

call home. I still love it with all my heart, but I did not have words to defend the events that have come to light in recent days, and so, instead of chatting with my friends, my husband, our dog and I went for a long pondering walk.

Personally, I do not know anyone with racist views, but I'm not naïve enough to believe racism does not exist; is not rampant in this country. What I find particularly disturbing is that people of power and authority; medical professionals and care-givers; those who have the opportunity to show love and compassion, in some instances, are often found to demonstrate hate and brutality, which festers and grows.

I don't know what we can do as individuals. My go to solution is always prayer, but more is required to deal with this ongoing, ugly side of our society, I think. Love is another way to show support and solidarity – a simple smile given to someone who, for the most part, feels left out, isolated, unloved by the majority of people they encounter. Give a smile and a kind word. Do not ignore people who are not like you; do not speak the way you do, or look the way you look. It's a tiny step, but it's a beginning. The Year of St. Joseph - On December 8 2020, Pope Francis declared a "**Year of St. Joseph**" marking the 150th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Saint Joseph as the Patron Saint of the Universal Church. This year continues until December 8, 2021, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

Although we read little about St. Joseph in the Bible, we know that he holds a central role in both the life of Jesus and in salvation history. In **Patris Corde: With a Father's Heart**, Pope Francis writes, "After Mary, the Mother of God, no saint is mentioned more frequently in the papal magisterium than Joseph, her spouse." He is the Patron Saint of many – workers, fathers, travelers, unborn children, immigrants, dying a happy death and is the Patron Saint of Canada. His quiet strength and obedience serves as a model of faith for all.

In **Patris Corde: With a Father's Heart**, Pope Francis highlights seven characteristics of St. Joseph, each meant to inspire us to live our own faith more deeply by emulating his qualities. Pope Francis describes St. Joseph as a beloved, tender and loving, obedient, accepting, creatively courageous, working father and ultimately a father in the shadows. All the characteristics show us how Joseph loved Jesus - with a father's heart. By his loving devotion, he is both a model for Christian living and a visible sign of how God loves each of us. Pope Francis writes that, "The aim of this Apostolic Letter is to increase our love for this great saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal." We encourage you to read the letter and discover anew the great attributes of St. Joseph, Patron Saint of the Universal Church. (From the Hamilton Diocese website.)
