



I encourage you to trust and believe in the Heart of Jesus' desire to continue effecting His healing interventions either in your life, perhaps a family member's life situation, or even a neighbour or a friend's needs. Come to our First Friday monthly Mass for Healing and be part of a growing faithfilled, and healing prayer beginning in St. Mary of the Assumption on the up-coming First Friday of June – June 7th at 7:00 pm. I will pray for healing with individuals at the end of each mass. God bless you all.


