## From the Pastor's Desk:

On the last Sunday of Easter we sang: "Lord, send forth your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth". I've been contemplating these words of the psalm, asking the Lord to help me know their meaning for my life and for my time. The petition that God "send forth His Spirit" is an unusual prayer of petition. Most of our petitions directed to God speak of our personal needs: "Lord, help me in this problem, heal this sickness, forgive this sin, etc." On Pentecost Sunday the Church invites us to ask God to give us what He already promised, and what He already gave to the Church, His Spirit. Perhaps this is a spiritual lesson for us, a lesson of continually asking God for what God wants for us. God's promise of the Holy Spirit is the Heavenly gift, a gift offered based on God's evaluation from His vantage point. God sends us what He believes we need, even when

we don't see the need for it. In praying for the gift of the Holy Spirit we are invited to enter into the very desire of God, to the heart of God, asking for God's will to be done. We continue to pray "...and renew the face of the earth". Here the psalm teaches us that there is a purpose to God's gift of the Holy Spirit. God's Spirit is given in order to renew what was once new and has become a bit old and worn out. I think of people who restore old cars, how much care they take to renew that which was once new but is in need of restoration. God's spirit is sent to restore the face of the earth, beginning with each one of us. This restoration must begin with me, with you, with individuals. It is our life of faith that must be restored first, our relationship with God. Only in God can we find the necessary vision and will for every other relationship in this world. The first step must be towards God. When we try to bypass God and focus just on our relationships with one another, with this world, with nations, etc. we run the risk of making mistakes and bringing hurt (even when unintended) to this world. Just look at all the political systems that started with good sounding ideas and good intentions, and because they rejected God ended up causing more hurt and pain. We cannot renew the world unless we start with God. "Renew the face of the earth" - God is the one who does the renewing, and we must be rooted in Him if we want to bring peace, healing, forgiveness, equity, etc. to our human relationships. The process of renewal and restoration comes from God, begins with me and you, and proceeds with the Holy Spirit to the community at large. I ask that we will never tire of asking God to accomplish for us what He desires and wills.




