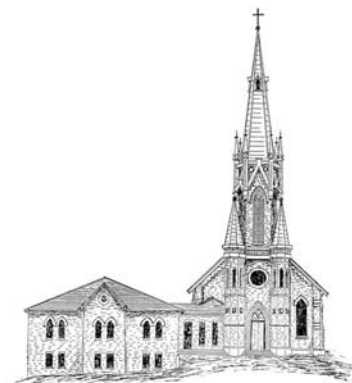

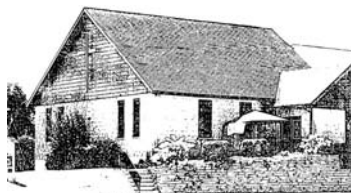

From Fr. James' Desk:

A monthly mass for healing calls us to hear and experience Jesus' words that say; "I am come that they may have life and have it to the full!" His many loving and merciful healing events in the gospels convince us that the risen Lord wants to keep raising up His people through physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual healing interventions. I myself am a recipient of his healing love and interventions, because 60 years ago I was on the brink of death from a serious brain damaging road traffic accident. After 17 days

of a comatose condition, and daily serious deterioration, brain surgeons stood at the bottom of my bed and told my parents "...do not come back tomorrow, he will not be here." My mother's faith expression was what the Heart of Jesus used to begin the healing plan that He had in mind for me. As a priest, I have been graced to celebrate healing masses and pray for physical, emotional and spiritual healing with people in Ireland, Israel and here across the Diocese of Hamilton. I have been humbled to witness so many healing interventions in varied situations. I encourage you to trust and believe in the Heart of Jesus' desire to continue effecting His healing interventions either in your life, perhaps a family member's life situation, or even a neighbour or a friend's needs. Come to our First Friday monthly Mass for Healing and be part of a growing faith-filled, and healing prayer beginning in St. Mary of the Assumption on the up-coming First Friday of June – June 7th at 7:00 pm. I will pray for healing with individuals at the end of each mass. God bless you all.
