In the Parish

Collective Mass Intentions - Beginning in January 2026, there will be a change in the scheduling of Mass intentions. Our Diocese allows us to offer Masses (except on Sundays) for multiple intentions. We will begin this in the New Year on **Saturdays at the 5:00 pm Mass in Owen Sound**. The Mass can be offered for multiple intentions because each Mass is infinite value and the grace is not "divided" between the intentions, but each intention receives the full benefit of the Mass. When there are multiple intentions, they will all be read aloud at the Mass.



Also, at this time the scheduling and publication of private Masses will be discontinued. These changes will provide more flexibility in the scheduling of Mass intentions and gives us the ability to accept more Mass intentions on short notice. If you have any questions, please see Fr. John.

Update on Weekday Morning Masses – Just a reminder that we no longer have Monday morning Masses, and as of **December 23**, we will not be having Tuesday morning Mass. The remaining weekday schedule will remain unchanged.

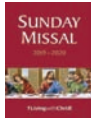
