

From the Pastor's Desk:

Have you ever had a conversation with someone that has stayed with you for days? This happened to me the other day. A friend who grew up with me and who is now married and has young children gave me a call. We chatted about a few things of no great significance, but eventually the conversation turned to

his recent experience when he took his children to an Evangelical church for what he called a "Rock Church Experience". This was a combination of upbeat Christian rock music and preaching. He told me that his kids loved it, and were much more excited to go back to it than to go to the Catholic Mass. His advice to me was: "Why can't we make Mass more like that? Why can't we make the experience of 'Church' more enjoyable to the kids and the adults alike?" Our conversation ended before I could really entertain his question properly, and it's good it did, because I felt like I needed to wrestle with this question for a bit. To be honest, I'm still wrestling with it. To be honest, I've been thinking about this problem for a long time, and I know many of you have as well. Why aren't the kids, the younger generation, going to Church? Is there something we can do to get more people to come to Mass? Or perhaps the more important question: to get them to keep going to Mass? You see, I grew up in a church that made the youth Mass very attractive: the band was playing, the young people were reading, there was pizza and social after Mass, there were retreats, etc. It was certainly more attractive for the youth to come, but the reality is why many of them didn't continue after the music ended and life took them deeper into adulthood. I ask myself what made some stay with it and some leave it? One possible approach to this "staying in church problem" is the one my friend proposed: "keep it exciting, entertaining". Another possible approach is "bring meaning and understanding". I think about what made me stay, and even become a priest, even as my friends left. Was it the exciting music, the pizza, and the frills that satisfied at the moment? Perhaps that helped initially, but ultimately it wasn't those things that kept me in. It was a deeper experience of God through knowledge and prayer. Could we do more to attract the youth to our church? Definitely, and we'll need to continue to find energy and creativity to do this, and men/women who are willing to help. But will it be enough? I don't know, I continue to think about it. Finding new ways to preach the message of Jesus is the ongoing work of the Church, but acceptance of that call to follow Jesus is always left to the individual and this too must be respected. Let me know if you would like to assist in any way or if you have ideas for attracting the youth to Jesus and His Church.


* In the Parish *




