The month of November begins with two special feasts: All Saints (Nov. 1) and All Souls (Nov. 2). These make us stop and consider our lives, and the lives we want to live. They help us to consider our mortality, our limited time here on earth. These make us consider the blessing that is our faith. It is so easy to get caught up in the ever

demanding aspects of our daily life, to become so focused on living, surviving, maybe even thriving, that we can lose our life and miss the beauty to which we are called. We need wake up calls, and hopefully ones that are not too damaging or serious (like a grave illness...), but just enough to keep us focused on that which is most important. Without our proper focus we will lose on both fronts: we'll miss out on the beauty of this life, and we'll miss out on heaven. During the month of November we are asked to show love to the Holy Souls in Purgatory, this is our Christian tradition. Safety Measures for Returning to Church: Given the number of restrictions still in place, Bishop Crosby has extended his dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for those who may feel uncomfortable to attend at this point. Please make your own decision in this regard. Anyone who is feeling sick or who has travelled outside the country in the last 14 days is asked not to come to church. Our weekend Masses are offered in Lion's Head, Tobermory, Owen Sound, Meaford, Chatsworth, Sauble Beach and Wiarton.

We will be following the safety protocol while at church, as has been outlined in Bishop Crosby's letter to parishioners. Here are a few highlights in summary form:

- Mask wearing is mandatory; and when you arrive at the church doors you will be greeted by one of our ushers who will invite you to sanitize your hands
- You'll be asked to sit in such a way as to respect the social distancing rule of 2 meters. Members of the same household do not have to follow that rule and can sit together. Wearing safety masks is encouraged, and we will have some available for those who need them.
- 3. All printed materials have been removed from the pews: hymnals, Sunday missals, etc. there will be no singing by the congregation.
- 4. There will be no lectors or extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion during this time. The priest will be the only one in the sanctuary.
- 5. When coming up for Holy Communion, social distancing of 2 meters will be observed. One side of the church will come up for Communion, in a single row, and then the other side.
- Before reaching the priest the mask will be lowered, and Communion is to be offered, in the hand only, without any exchange of words between the priest and the communicant.
- 7. Collection is to be placed in the baskets on the way out of church, and there should be no socializing with one another before or after Mass.
- 8. Printed bulletins will not be available, instead parishioners will be able to view the bulletin on our website.
- Confession will not be offered before or after weekend Masses, but we continue to offer Confession by appointment and one half hour before weekday Masses.

I hope that all these steps undertaken by our churches will provide extra protection for our parishioners and their loved ones. Please follow these as best as you can. I hope to see you soon as we return to a somewhat normal church practice.

Bruce Grey Catholic District School Board - Board of Trustees Meeting Highlights, October 26: Naming of the Virtual Elementary School: The students in our temporary virtual elementary school were asked to select possible names for the school. They submitted their suggestions, along with a brief description of why that Saint was nominated. Trustees reviewed the names and decided to narrow down the list to St. Thomas Aguinas, St. Isidore,

St. Kateri, and St. Edmund, and then let the students vote to decide.

The arguments for St. Kateri: She is the first saint who is of indigenous origins and she is also the saint of the environment and ecology. She was a strong woman who refused to marry because she wanted to devote her life to God. At 19, she took a vow of Catholicism and devoted her life to helping people and serving God. I believe this could be an action of recognition and reconciliation to the Indigenous population for all the hardships they have endured.


