



More details on our progress will be coming as an insert in the bulletin in the next few weeks. Thanks to the great members of our Building Committee who are working very hard.

Ex Corde Foundation of the Diocese of Hamilton has generously accepted our submission for funds to help cover the cost of a new roof on St. Stanislaus Church in Chatsworth, and a new heating furnace in St. Mary's Church in Hepworth. Thank you to Bishop Douglas Crosby and the members of the Ex Corde Foundation which exists to provide financial assistance to parishes in need.

Fr. James is enjoying his sabbatical experience in Ireland. Time flies and we will see him soon when he returns to us for Christmas. My special thanks to Fr. Tom Moison and Fr. Anthony Azzoparti for their generous help during Fr. James' sabbatical. I have heard wonderful feedback from parishioners about Fr. Tom and Fr. Anthony. I also want to say how proud I am of our good parishioners who have been very welcoming to our visiting priests.

This week is the Annual Priests' Seminar, a time when all the priests from the Diocese of Hamilton spend 3 days together. This means that Fr. Emmanuel, Matt, and I will be away from the parish on Wednesday until Friday this week. Masses will be cancelled during our time away, so please look at the Mass intentions schedule on this page (to the left) if you are a daily Mass attendee. Please pray for us, especially for me, that I behave myself and don't say anything silly.

A Seminarian's Thoughts:

What about spiritual formation at the minor seminary? The Legionaries taught us to pray. One forms the habit of prayer by praying at the same time every day. We would rise at 6am and have Morning Prayer in the chapel at 6:20. At 6:30 we had a half-hour of meditation. It was a guided meditation, i.e., one of the priests or brothers would lead us out loud in prayer, always opening with acts of faith, hope, and love in Almighty God. In eastern meditation, increasingly popular today, one goes inside to find peace and calm and shut out the world. In Christian mediation we go inside to find God, the Holy Spirit dwelling in us through the Sacrament of baptism and the state of sanctifying grace. At 7am was Mass, the highlight of our day. We put a lot of effort into making our Masses as reverent and solemn as possible. At every Mass the King of kings, the Creator of the universe, Yahweh in the flesh, comes down to us on the altar at the priest's words. The reverence with which the priests handled the Blessed Sacrament witnessed to the gravity of this precious moment. At Holy Communion we would approach the altar rail and kneel down to receive the Lord of lords from the consecrated hands of the priest, a fitting expression of our belief in the Real Presence of Christ in every tiny host. The Music at our Masses was beautiful. We emphasized sacred music, the rich musical heritage of our tradition. We sang hymns, but also a lot of Gregorian chant, which, as Vatican II tells us, should be given "pride of place" in the liturgy. In all our prayer, we strived to "worship God acceptably with reverence and awe" (Heb. 12:28) Matt


