

### From the Pastor's Desk:

Recently I received an email from a parishioner who has experienced harsh criticism from family and friends regarding the Catholic Church. I responded by providing some assistance for navigating such encounters. In case this is of help to others, I include my reflection below.

Regarding how to respond to criticism of the Church. This is not an easy one. Those who volunteer their criticism are usually quite proud and unable to see their own sinfulness, which is why they come across

so strongly and judgmentally. They usually speak much about the faults of others, and never mention their own.

In my response I usually try to follow a few rules:

- 1. I try not to take the responsibility for others, but only for myself. When given a chance to respond I will say: "I can't speak for others, but I can tell you why I'm staying with the Church, if you would like to know". This shifts the conversation away from judgment of others and towards sharing myself with others. They can choose to agree or disagree, and that is their choice. We all have to make decisions for ourselves. The main point here is to offer my own experience without feeling like I have to convince others. They will decide for themselves.
- 2. In responding I will usually make a point that those who made or make bad decisions in the church are doing so by going against the Church's teachings and not by following the teachings. Again I will speak of how following the teachings of the Church helps me to feel better, to live better, and to be better.
- 3. In responding to the humanist ideas of what is morality and how one should live, I will simply say that we all follow certain morality. Mine is based on the teachings from the Bible, and secular society makes their own morality as they go. Regarding exclusion of some people, it must be recognized that every moral system by its existence excludes certain behaviors. It does not, or should not, exclude people; But it does disagree with certain ways of living. The Catholic Church is not different. In the act of criticizing the Church many people are passing judgement on those who choose to live according to the Church's teaching. I would venture to say that they are more harsh in their criticism than the Catholic Church's approach. We are called to love the sinner and hate the sin. The secular approach usually leads to hating the one they perceive as sinners according to their secular morality.
- 4. At the end of the day, it is very important not to get into any arguments with people who are angry. Remember that when Jesus was interrogated by the self-righteous of his day, he remained silent. There is time for sharing and responding, but there is also time for silence. If I see that the person who is criticizing is angry and not open to hearing my perspective, I usually end the conversation by saying something like: "Feel free to live your life, and let me live mine. Be at peace, no one is being forced to practice the Catholic faith, and no one should be forced or shamed to cease following it. Live and let live".

I've also heard the phrase used: "One does not leave Jesus because of Judas".

I hope these thoughts help. Blessings, Fr. Kuzma




